They have told you that before you go to 'Luna Park' you need to plan your trip so that you can make sure you don't spend all your money too quickly and so that you can do all the activities you want.

You will need to complete the following tasks to prepare for your day at 'Luna Park':

- You will be at Luna Park from 9:00am until 2:00pm
- Remember to have a break for morning tea and lunch
- You must at least go on one ride, attend one show and buy one souvenir

Task 1:

Task 2:

Today your job is to calculate your spending for your rides and entertainment. You will look at food, drink and souvenirs tomorrow so make sure you don't spend all your money today. You need to include how much it costs, how many times you will do the ride and activity and how much the total will be. I have included a table to help you set it out and one example to show you what to do.

Task 3:

Next you need to calculate your spending for your food, drinks and souvenirs. You will need to look at your plan from Task 1 and use that to write how much money you are planning to spend on food, drink and souvenirs. You need to include how much it costs, how many of each item you will purchase and how much the total will be. I have included a table to help you set it out and one example to show you what to do.

Task 4:

It's time to make your timetable. You will need to look at how long each activity will take you and plan your whole day. There is a template for the timetable below to help you. I have included one example to show you what to do.

Don't forget that you need to plan from 9:00am - 2:00pm and you need to have a morning tea and lunch break.

Task 5:

Congratulations, you have planned your amazing day at 'Luna Park'. The final thing you need to do is to write a letter to your parents telling them how much you will spend on the day and how much change you have left. You can include some of the activities you are most excited to do with your family.
